OUCH!—In October the congregation approved a budget with projected income falling \$18,275 less than budgeted expenses. Only \$5,000 was allocated for facilities repairs & equipment (R & E) with the hope that significant repairs would not be required during the year. Unfortunately repairs to our alarm system, a furnace, and sump pump plus the insurance deductible will push our R & E expenses to \$9,400 before the end of December, 2017. At the next congregational meeting the congregation will be asked to increase the R & E budget line item to \$15,000. Please consider increasing your contributions to CMCL to help cover the revised projected income shortfall of \$28,000. Facilities Committee
