Suspected Child Abuse Incident Report Community Mennonite Church of Lancaster

Person Receiving an Initial Report or Observing an Incident Shall:

- 1. Remove the child from imminent danger.
- 2. If a child is injured or in pain, call 911 for an ambulance.
- 3. Take the child's word seriously and keep any physical evidence.
- 4. Stay calm and listen carefully to the child.
- 5. Ask open-ended questions (i.e., "Can you tell me what happened?") instead of leading questions.
- 6. Provide emotional support; let the child know that he/she did the right thing by talking about the problem.
- 7. Assure the child that appropriate action will be taken.
- 8. An employee or an Approved Adult who has reasonable cause to suspect that a child/youth under their care, guidance or supervision, or a child/youth not directly under their care, guidance or supervision but involved in any church program or activity, has been abused by anyone (including but not limited to the child/youth's family, guardians, an Approved Adult or volunteer) shall immediately inform a pastor or the Director of C & Y Programs and document the suspected abuse in the space below....
