# 2. Approval of March Minutes

## 3. March Financial Report

#### a. Offerings & Expenses

- -Offerings are \$18,000 ahead of last year
- -Rent income is higher due to Chestnut Housing/Grant Street apartment
- -Income is ahead of expenses
- -We are 58% into the year, but have only used 51% of expenses
- -\$31,000 in the black

#### b. CD with Everence

-Larry is in the process of opening up a CD with Everence. There are a few extra steps which have prolonged the process-such as opening a membership account first. Once we open this account, we will get \$4,700 within the first year.

### c. Updated Budget Procedure:

-The new budget procedure is the same for the most part, just consolidated and a few dates rearranged.

Drew motions to approve the updated budget procedure. John seconds. All in favor.

# d. Grant St. Fundraising Goal:

- -Dave Lutz suggests keeping the donation goal where it is, since there are a few things that we still need to finance/address with the property:
  - -Moisture issue in basement
  - -Finish furnishing the space
  - -Air Conditioner unit may not be sufficient

John motions to approve the March Financial Report. Margaret seconds. All in favor.

### 4. MCC Policies - Pauline Zimmerman & Maren Morgan

-Current MCC personal code of conduct policy is not straightforward. It is hard to find online. However, there is a published document saying individuals cannot go into service and be openly gay.

- -Pauline wrote a letter to Anne Hershberger (executive director of MCC) in January regarding the transparency of the policy.
- -Others are also asking for transparency. There is a petition already in motion by MCC staff to amend this policy.
- -Pauline would like CMCL to continue this conversation with the MCC USA Board asking for transparency about the policy. How much can CMCL support MCC if they have a policy of discrimination?

# Possible ways to move forward:

- -CMCL could contact other affirming churches who would support this initiative.
- -Pauline and Maren to draft a statement on behalf of CMCL and then submit to council for approval.
